We need **YOU** to volunteer and ensure that every vote is counted and **ONLY** counted once. Sign up to be on our **Election Integrity Task Force** and help ensure a fair election. Add your name [here](#) or visit [defendyourballot.com](http://defendyourballot.com).

### **Mail/Absentee Voting:**

**"All active registered voters will receive a mail ballot for the 2020 General Election. All voted mail ballots must be dropped off or mailed by Election Day. Mail ballot return envelopes must be postmarked on or before Election Day and received by the Election Department on or before the seventh day after Election Day. If you decide to vote in-person instead of by mail, you will need to do one of the following:**

**-Surrender your mail ballot (preferably in the packet sent to you) to an election official at the voting site.**

**-If you do not surrender your ballot, you will sign an affirmation at the voting site swearing that you have not already voted in the current election and that you understand no one may attempt to vote or actually vote more than once in the same election."**

### **Voting Options:**

**"EARLY VOTING** begins October 17<sup>th</sup> and ends on October 30, 2020 with various hours and locations. All early voting locations serve as drop off locations for further convenience.

**ELECTION DAY** is Tuesday, November 3, 2020 from 7am to 7pm.

MAIL BALLOT DROP OFF LOCATIONS will be available starting September 28, 2020 at various locations. Locations will be included in the mail ballot packet that will be mailed to each active voter.

**Make sure your voter registration is up to date. You can register to vote or update registration at [vote.gop/nv](http://vote.gop/nv).**

"Standard Close of Registration, Tuesday, October 6, 2020 - Close of Mail-In, DMV voter registration/updates and In-Person Standard Registration: Last day to register to vote or to update your existing registration by mail or in-person at the Election Department. Online Close of Registration, Tuesday, October 7 - 15, 2020 – Last day to register online through the Secretary of State's Website at [www.RegistertoVoteNV.gov](http://www.RegistertoVoteNV.gov).

Same Day Registration Period\* – Voters that register during this period will be required to present an unexpired Nevada Driver's License or Identification Card issued by the DMV. If you are already registered and you update your record during this period, you do not have to present ID. See our website for more information regarding Same Day Registration requirements at [www.clarkcountynv.gov/vote](http://www.clarkcountynv.gov/vote). Same Day Registration will be available at any Clark County Election Day Vote Center or at any early voting site.
