## **GUEST SPEAKER FOR OCTOBER MEETING – VIA ZOOM**

We welcome John Tsarpalas, President of the Nevada Policy Research Institute, as our Zoom speaker.

John is deeply committed to spreading limited government ideas and policies to create a better and more prosperous Nevada for all.

He spent the first 25 years of his career as a commercial construction contractor in Chicago. As government regulations and state and local taxes expanded exponentially in his home state of Illinois, he realized that, as a business owner, he had to become more active in the world of politics.



In 1996, when Newt Gingrich drafted the Contract with America, John became active in Republican political campaigns. After five campaigns where his candidates were the only Republicans elected in Democrat districts, he was recruited to become the Executive Director of the Illinois Republican Party in 2005. As Executive Director he graduated from the Republican National Committee's Campaign College and the RNC's Field Management School.

After being terribly disappointed by Republican votes in the Illinois State House and Congress, John left the party to pursue alternate routes to making change. As President of the Sam Adams Alliance, his focus was on educating activists and building support organizations to help the free enterprise and limited government movements in 10 states. On the national level he was part of the team that started the Franklin Center for Government & Public Integrity and American Majority with chapters in 23 states.

After the Sam Adams Alliance, John partnered to start the following educational not-for-profits: Think Freely Media, the Haym Salomon Center for Jewish American Thought, and Midwest Speaking Professionals.

A former native of the economically and politically bankrupt state of Illinois, John now lives in Henderson, Nevada, with his wife of 41 years.

### **MAIL-IN BALLOT AND VOTING IN PERSON**



The decision to have a mail-in ballot election means we all get a ballot, not just those that request an absentee ballot. You only get to vote once, of course. The ballot mailed to you is the only one you will get.

- Complete it and mail it (postage is prepaid) –OR--
- Complete and drop it at a drop box –OR--
- Take it to a polling location to vote in person

You must sign the back of the envelope for your vote to count. Be sure then to get it in by 7pm November 3<sup>rd</sup>.

You may take another person's completed ballot and place it in a drop box for them. Do not place two ballots in one envelope.

As for election integrity, if you see something, say something. There are criminal investigators and observers but most election interference must be reported by the public.

Early voting starts October 17 and goes through October 30. November 3<sup>rd</sup>, election day 7am to 7pm. If you are in line at that time, you will be allowed to vote. If you are not in line, you missed the deadline. Shame on you!

**Sun City Anthem will have early voting October 28, 29 & 30 and then again on Election Day November 3<sup>rd</sup>.**

***Volunteers are still needed to help candidates and to monitor polling sites.***

**OUR OWN CLUB'S 2021 OFFICERS ELECTION**

In view of the meeting restrictions imposed upon us by COVID-19 and the governor's rules, voting for 2021 officers will be online ONLY. Members will need to login to the website in order to vote. Online voting will begin on October 16, and will remain open through November 2. Winners will be announced at the November 2020 meeting and by emails.

**WAIVER OF DUES FOR 2021 FOR EXISTING 2020 MEMBERS**

All current Republican Club SCA members who have paid dues for 2020 on or before October 31 will have dues considered paid for 2021. This is a one-time dues waiver due to Covid-19 and Community Lifestyle Committee recommendations.

Initial dues of \$10 paid by a new member after October 31, 2020 will be credited to the balance of 2020 plus all of 2021. This is pursuant to the Club's current by-laws.

A new member joining after December 31, 2020, will pay regular annual dues of \$10 applicable to 2021.
