For those wishing to attend in person, please call Darlene Davis at 702-617-4499. Reservations will be taken for the first 50 club members only. Only those with a reservation will be admitted into the room. All mask and social distancing requirements will be enforced. We will have a 50/50 drawing for those present at the meeting at the Delaware Room, Anthem Center. Enter at the Ballroom entrance.

To join a Zoom meeting from your PC, go to the website [zoom.us/download](https://zoom.us/download). Click on the first download option. Then click on the .exe file and it will automatically install on your computer. It will ask for the meeting ID and password. To use your phone or iPad, download the Zoom Meeting Mobile App from the App store or Google Play.

The Zoom meeting ID and password will be sent to you via email in September.

The decision to have a mail-in ballot election means we all get a ballot, not just those that request an absentee ballot. You only get to vote once, of course. The ballot mailed to you is the only one you will get. Complete it and mail it (postage is prepaid) or complete and drop it at a drop box or take it to an early polling location (Sun City Anthem will have early voting October 28 & 29 and then again on election day November 3<sup>rd</sup>). You must sign the back of the envelope for your vote to count. Be sure then to get it in by 7pm November 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Barbara Cegavske, Secretary of State, discussed the mail in ballot and the voting process at a zoom meeting. I feel very confident that fraud is very difficult to commit. Signatures are verified by computer and if questioned then by a human. If there is a question, the voter is given the opportunity to correct or verify the signature. You may access your voter registration at [registertovotenv.gov](http://registertovotenv.gov) if you have forgotten how you sign and if your registration is correct. You may also register to vote at this site. This is an open election meaning everyone gets the same ballot. You may also view the counting of ballots, contact Clark County election official Joe Gloria.

The biggest problem will be ballot harvesting, that is gathering ballots for others. This is new legislation for this election only. The hope is that everyone will be able to vote in secret and not be coerced by bosses or unions or caregivers, etc. Please alert others to this and ask them to vote their own ballot and encourage others to do only their own. As for taking them for someone else to a drop off location, that is not a problem; it is the actual voting that can be swayed by an unscrupulous person.

The primary threats to voter integrity are foreign phishing, terrorism in the States and election day integrity. So, if you see something, say something. There are criminal investigators and observers but most election interference must be reported by the public.

Look for your ballot in late September; they are delivered in batches. Early voting starts October 17 and goes through October 30. November 3<sup>rd</sup>, election day 7am to 7pm. If you are in line at that time, you will be allowed to vote. If you are not in line, you missed the deadline. Shame on you!
