

## DC COLLINS REPORTS ON THE CLARK COUNTY REPUBLICAN CENTRAL COMMITTEE



### Clark County Republican Party

We should have also included the state's Nevada Republican Party (<https://nevadagop.org>). We highly recommend you sign up to get their updates to stay informed on key legislative actions and breaking issues. To be a voting member of the Nevada Republican Central Committee (NCRCC) you must first be a member of the CCRCC and be elected from this group to the state central committee.

All of these groups will welcome you to attend their meetings, receive their newsletters, volunteer in their various outreach programs and of course—DONATE cash to support their efforts.

CCRCC meetings typically meet the third Tuesday every other month. Of course, nothing has been typical in the past year and they've been very constrained by the Governor's meeting mandates. You may sign up on the website by completing a new member application (<https://clarkgop.org/application.html>). You will then receive notices from the CCRCC and can attend the next meeting, although voting privileges are not established until the second meeting. The CCRCC mission is:

- Increasing Republican voter registrations.
- Identifying, recruiting, and supporting Republican candidates for office.
- Establishing ongoing efforts to raise money to promote Republican candidates.
- Concentrating on grass roots efforts in local communities
- Participating in community functions so the Republican brand is better

- Increasing Republican voter turnout by increasing voter awareness, reaching out to voters and provide rides when necessary.
- Always being organized and professional.

## **CRAIG SMITH REPORTS ON THE CLARK COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT**

### **Clark County School Board, May, 2021**

On May 13, 2021 the Clark County School Board voted to approve an extension to Superintendent Jesus Jara's contract in a 4-3 vote. The extension ends a dispute over whether the contract had automatically renewed for the past two years and instead defines his term as beginning June 19, 2018, and ending Jan. 15, 2023.

Trustees Katie Williams, Lola Brooks, Evelyn Garcia Morales and Irene Cepeda voted to approve the extension, while Danielle Ford, Lisa Guzman and Linda Cavazos voted against.

There is also a proposal to change the grading system in the Clark County School District. A board meeting vote on the following proposed changes is likely by early July:

- Students would be allowed to retake tests and redo assignments;
- the minimum possible grade would be 50%, not zero; and
- a student could turn in assignments late without it penalizing their grade.

Another example of dumbing down our children.

## **CRAIG SMITH REPORTS ON THE HENDERSON CITY COUNCIL**

### **Henderson City Council Meeting, May**

On May 18, 2021 the Henderson City Council unanimously approved the FY 2022 City budget. The overall Citywide budget is \$679 million and includes a \$295 million General Fund Budget. Budget highlights include the addition of 15 new police officers and construction of a police sub-station in west Henderson.

Also included in the FY 2022 budget is a 3 cent property tax increase from \$0.74 to \$0.77 per \$100 in assessed value. According to Chief Financial Officer, Jim McIntosh, the increase will not affect the vast majority of existing residents because of Nevada property tax cap, which protects homeowners from increases of more than three percent. The budget was item #36 on the May 18, 2021 Agenda.

Convention of States Action is a national organization whose goal is to call a Convention of States which will suggest Constitutional Amendments. The subject areas for those amendments are term limits, fiscal responsibility and limiting the power and jurisdiction of the Federal Government. **They will have a table at the meeting with literature and people ready to answer your questions about Convention of States.**

Bill Harenburg is the Nevada District Captain for Assembly District 23 for the Convention of States Project and serves on the Prayer Warrior team. Convention of States Project is a group of people organized at the national and state level to work with State Legislators to call an Article V Convention of States which will suggest Constitutional Amendments.

### **Tyre Gray, Nevada Mining Association, Spoke at the May Meeting**



Tyre L. Gray, Esq., President of the Nevada Mining Association, is a charismatic thought-leader. Known for his big laugh and positive outlook, Tyre cut his teeth as an educator at an at-risk learning academy before transitioning into the private sector where he spent the past two decades acquiring a wide variety of skills holding leadership positions in the consulting, resorts, and legal industry.

There are 103 mines in Nevada. 3.19 million pounds of minerals, metals and fuels are mined each year. Gold for tech products, Silver for solar panels, Lithium and Copper for batteries, Diatomite for beer, but no diamonds are mined here in Nevada. Mining is the 12<sup>th</sup> largest industry in the state, annually ranks 4-6 as highest taxpayer in the state, and pays the highest per employee in taxes. Mineral prices are set internationally, so when taxes are increased on mining, there is a 30% direct contraction in the industry. After a mine is finished, the land is returned back to the pristine condition it was before operations started.
