Amendment to the Nevada
Constitution

Assembly Joint Resolution No. 10
of the 80th Session

Shall the Nevada Constitution be amended, effective July 1, 2024, to:
(1) establish the State's minimum wage that employers must pay to certain employees at a rate of \$12 per hour worked, subject to any applicable increases above that \$12 rate provided by federal law or enacted by the Nevada Legislature; (2) remove the existing provisions setting different rates for the minimum wage based on whether the employer offers certain health benefits to such employees; and (3) remove the existing provisions for adjusting the minimum wage based on applicable increases in the cost of living?
